

# God Acts In Due Season

*Galatians 4:1-7, "Now I say, That the heir, as long as he is a child, differeth nothing from a servant, though he be lord of all; But is under tutors and governors until the time appointed of the father. Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world; **But when the fullness of time was come, God sent forth his Son**, made of a woman, made under the law, To redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons. And because ye are sons, God hath sent forth the Spirit of his Son into your hearts, crying, Abba, Father. Wherefore thou art no more a servant, but a son; and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ."*

This promise was fulfilled when God Himself became flesh in Jesus Christ. The fullness of time came to make this promise alive up to our days. We may walk our path thankfully and full of joy, for we approach more and more those glorious promises, which will also be fulfilled in our life in due season. He will give the revelation in His time, and that is when we will need it. In due season means in His time, which He has already set before the foundation of the world. I love to remember the Word of Ecclesiastes 3:15,

*"That which hath been is now; and that which is to be hath already been; and God requireth that which is past."*

Further we read in Ecclesiastes 8:5-6,

*"A wise man's heart discerneth both time and judgment. Because to every purpose there is time..."*

Oh, let's remember, as soon as God spoke His Word, it was finished for ever. *"And God said: Let there be light! And there was light"* (Genesis 1:3). How many years there were in between, only God knows - yet there was

light! All promises that God spoke took already place for Him, and it became manifested in and among us in His time.

So unauthorized interpretations and intellectual reasonings, self-efforts and endeavor are totally out of place. This is the way of the serpent, as we can see in Genesis 3:4-5. The serpent said: "Ye shall surely not die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." The false interpretation of the Word brought death, misery and all the sorrows to mankind.

Therefore time has really come, that we are totally ready to die to our old habits, our own thoughts and ideas, that God's thoughts are born into us and the mind of Christ could be in us - His Word mind. We have to die off of the old religious systems which we were in, and they have to rot. This has to take place before the real rebirth from above can take place. The dying out brings forth the rebirth (St.John 3:1-8; St.John 12:20-25).

If we have truly realized, that we all together are no good, we stop our own opinions, own revelations, arguments, the religious know-it-all. Doesn't God's Word say in Romans 3:12,

*"They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one."*

Then falls every religious condemning spirit silent, every megalomania and hypocritical bigotry dies off, and we live only by the revelation given by the Holy Ghost (Romans 1:17). It is given to us by grace, we cannot deserve it (Eph. 2:3-10). The Bridegroom, our Lord Jesus Christ, reveals Himself to His Bride. It is and remains undeserved grace, when He makes Himself known and reveals His Word to us (I Peter 1:13).

His sons will be made alive and quickened in the Word age, in which we live right now, through God's Spirit. Like a spark that sets something on fire, they are brought to life and placed into heavenly places (Eph. 2:4-7). They are alive and have a part in the promises of our time - partake in every promise of the Word. Oh, isn't that wonderful! Shouldn't this fact make us to rejoice? His Word children are dead to the world and live in Jesus Christ. They live in this present time, in order that the Word might be manifested and fulfilled, which God has predestinated. Whatever He predestinated in His Word, He fulfills by proving Himself His Word as true. By His foreknowledge, He predestinated it in this way. He predestinated the Bride, She will be there. The Rapture will take place. Beforehand the Bride will come into perfection (St.Matthew 5:48). He will present to Himself a glorious Church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing, but that it

should be holy and without blemish (Eph. 5:27). The fullness of adoption will take place (Romans 8:19-21). When the dynamics fall, the Bride will experience the true refilling with the Holy Spirit (I Peter 1:3-9). In a moment this mortal being will put on immortality, and we will be taken from the earth in the Rapture (I Thess. 4:13-17). How glorious is the Word of I Corinthians 15:51-54,

*"Behold, I shew you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed. In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory."*

Further it reads in Hebrews 12:26-29 that all things will be shaken, but the unmovable kingdom (His Word) in us will continue.

If His Word you receive and it falls in the right predestinated soil of faith in the heart, God will at any time confirm It as true (Mat. 13:23). That's what we need - His Word. He proves and confirms It. He keeps His Word! (Jeremiah 1:12). On this we can rest safely. That's the place where the believer is protected - behind the Word.

We have no right to question the Word intellectually. We just have to believe It. Whatever God says, so He makes it come to pass exactly. Don't let in own thoughts about it, but may the mind of Christ be in us (Philippians 2:5-11). He is the Word.

Each of His promises will be revealed to His Bride at the right time and hour (St.John 14:21). His Word will become evident at the right time according to His plan. Brother Branham said: The rest of it will become known to us about the time when Jesus comes to take His Bride. Let us pray until to this time, and look out for His coming, and live a good Christian life. Nobody knows when He comes to meet the Bride in the air (Mat. 24:42). But it will happen, the seven voices of the seven thunders will unveil this great revelation at that time. Therefore I believe, that although we know it not now, it yet will be revealed to us at the right time. It will be revealed at that day, when we have a reason to see it.

We should behave as true disciples, however. After they had received the word of promise of the Father, they returned to Jerusalem with great joy and

were continually in the temple praising and blessing God (St.Luke 24:44-52).

We too want to have faith in His Words, and praise and bless Him daily for the promises which we have already received, and will moreover meet yet. Let's remember His Word in II Corinthians 1:20,

*"For all promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us."*

May we experience again and again personally, how the Word of St.Luke 14:21 becomes real: "Today this Scripture is fulfilled before your ears!" So we can be certain, that all of His promises which He has given us personally will be manifested in us in His time.

How true are the Words of Ecclesiastes 3:1-11,

*"To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: A time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up that which is planted; ... a time to heal; ... a time to get; ... a time to keep silence, and a time to speak. ...*

*He hath made every thing beautiful in his time: also he hath set the world in their heart so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end."*
