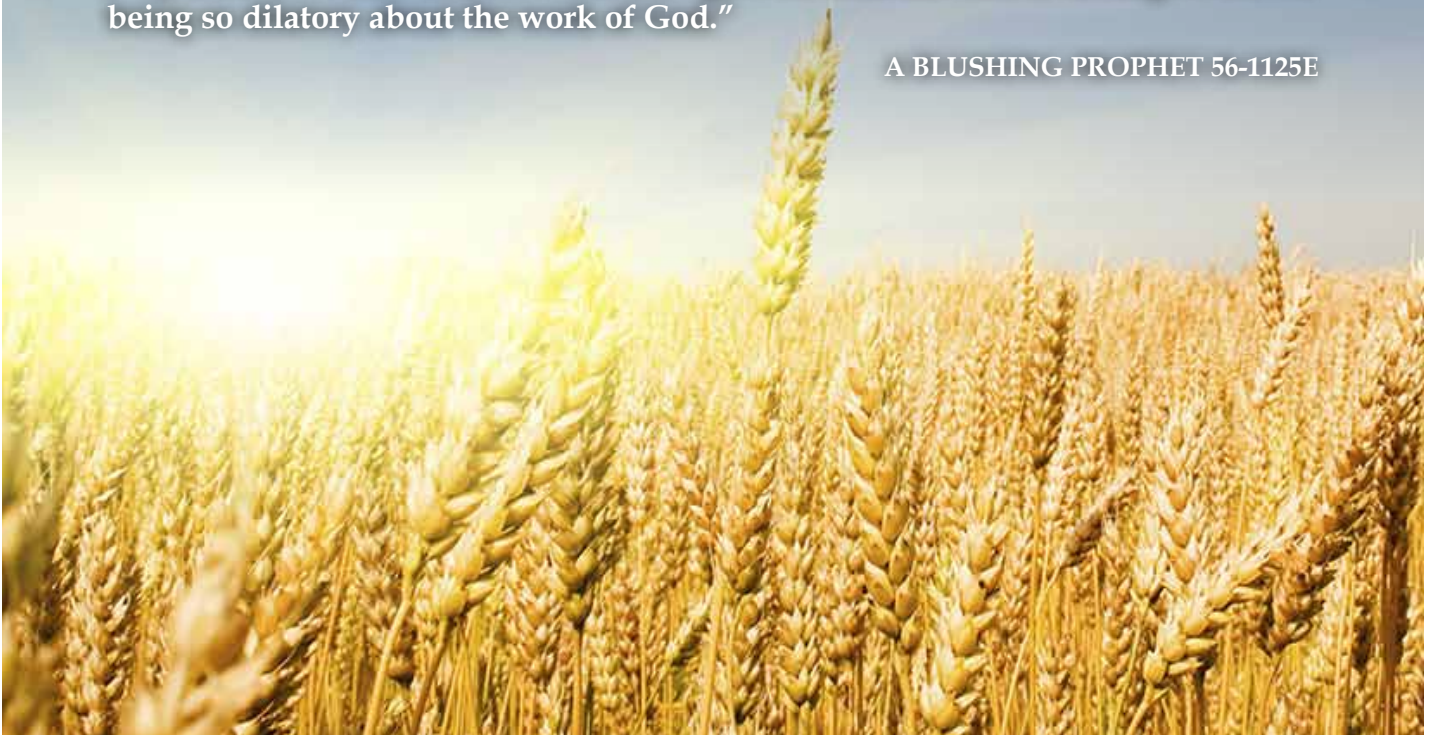

How we need to pray

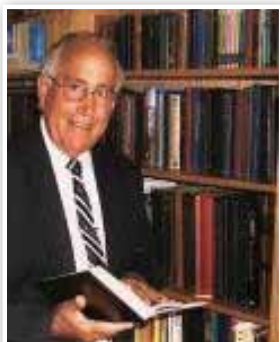

II CORINTHIANS 11:2

2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present [you as] a chaste virgin to Christ.

You hear in life the clichés that “it can’t be done”, “it’s never been done before” or “it won’t work”. These were the kind of attitudes that had to be pushed to the side in order that the South Pacific Convention could materialize.

One year ago Bro’ Paul Hinge from north Pentecost Island in Vanuatu was visiting our church in New Zealand and stayed at my home for two days. We decided to plan a convention in Vanuatu using his church as the host for meetings that would benefit the Saints in these remote islands in the Pacific. The odds were against us right from the start but I felt that it was the Lord’s will so we set this as a vision before us to walk into. The Saints on north Pentecost went to work immediately to plant their taros and other vegetables and then clear the grounds for building apartments for foreign visitors to stay in. January can be a fickle time of the year where heavy rains can cause havoc with transportation, and plane flights and ships have to be booked to correspond with the dates set for the meetings. Invitations were sent out through the BNL early so that foreign visitors could plan to have time off work and flights booked at a time of the year which is busy with tourists. I visited the convention site in November to check up on the progress of the buildings going up and was enthused by the quality of workmanship that had been put into the construction of the apartments and the overall planning expertise that the brethren had manifested.

When we all arrived in January, we were ushered into a freshly finished village of ten new apartments, a new kitchen and dining area: a new toilet & shower facility. The apartments were a mixture of double and single beds and bunk huts made out of bush materials. The sisters prepared our meals for us and I wish to thank them for the time they put into this task.

My desire was always to lift up the ministries that the Lord has within a nation and promote them before their own people and place less emphasis on foreign ministries. So half of the preaching at the convention was done by four of the native ministers and the other half by Bro. Johnny Dimov of Australia, Bro. Malcolm Ferris and Bro. Adrian Gray of N.Z.

There were a total of 17 meetings over the 6 days. I also wish to thank Bro Renato Zanoli and Bro' Jerry Sellers for their huge contribution to the success of meetings also. The numbers that attended the meetings was in the vicinity of 200 – 250. Anything more would have placed a lot of pressure on the supply of food.

W h a t stood out in these meetings was the extremely h i g h

quality preaching and the depth of revelation from the local ministers which I rate as being on par with the best anywhere. My special thanks go to all the ministers foreign and local that blended in together to make these meetings a real success.

We had ten visitors from Australia, nine from New Zealand and two from the USA as well as many from the outer islands. The compatibility was a pleasure to watch with everybody mixing with each other, helping and encouraging each other.

The maturity of the Saints in Vanuatu and the their local ministry can be gauged by what they are planning for the future from amongst themselves. The Vanuatu ministers sat down together and have decided on another convention at the end of this year on Santo Island. They have also planned a youth meeting in August on north Ambrym Island.

The Supernatural in Your Life

The Supernatural in your life. Now when I quote that, some of you might say- what supernatural? There is a realm of sensitivity that belongs to you. But it'll only be found in prayer. Everything that you need as a believer, if you are born again and Spirit filled, begins with prayer. Brother Branham said 'don't even open your Bible until you've first prayed, because,' he said, 'you cannot read this like you read a newspaper. You need the Holy Spirit to teach you spiritual things. And the purpose of prayer is to get your human spirit and body subject to the very Spirit of Christ.'

That takes some time and some doing. You can't just enter into that casually. I don't think we should ever enter into the presence of God casually. I believe that the Word of God is the presence of God, so that if I am going to enter into the presence of God, I should not enter into it casually. I should be in the Spirit. I should be in the Spirit of the Lord. I should be led by the Holy Spirit - The Supernatural in your life. Now, I want you to write this down as well, because this will be a theme. Whenever we are modelling the Cross we are being led by the Spirit. Whenever we are modelling the Cross!

That is why it is important to go over the events of the Cross from time to time, to see the nature of the Holy Spirit working in Jesus' life, how that the man did not want to die. He sweat drops of blood, tremendous anguish. David, in the Spirit, spoke of the anguish that Jesus went through, more so than Jesus did. We'll read that in a moment. By modelling the cross you are automatically being led by the Spirit. Whenever you model the cross before your children, before your wife. Whenever you model the cross before your husband, whenever you live out the sacrificial life of selflessness and living for others you are always walking in the Spirit. You are being led by the Spirit, and the Spirit, when you are modelling the Cross is then speaking to lives and the Scriptures are being fulfilled.

Now, let me say that again in short. Whenever you are modelling the Cross, you are being led by the Spirit. You are speaking to lives and the Scriptures are being fulfilled. Your life is fulfilling the Word of God. You are prophecy in motion. Your life that you are living, don't ever consider it, don't relegate it to hum-drum, to ordinary, just doing what I'm supposed to do. If you are in the realm of the Spirit you will become so sensitive and aware that your daily life is Scriptures being fulfilled. You are prophecy being fulfilled.

The Bible says that the Bible was not written by men that were naturally minded, but Holy men, under the anointing of the Holy Spirit wrote the Word of God. Most of the time it was men that were in duress, distress, anguish, prison, in a cave somewhere when the Bible was written.

Most of it was not written in Kings palaces or in beautiful homes. Many authors today get away from the humdrum and they get

away to the mountains to write their book. They seek a little cabin by a lake somewhere and they write their book.

That was not the case for Jeremiah; that was not the case for Moses; that was not the case for David; that was not the case for Paul. 11 Peter 1:20-21 -*Knowing this first, that no prophesy of the scriptures is of any private interpretation, for the prophesy came not in old time by the will of man, but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.* I don't believe that the Pillar of Fire came into the room and told him "pick up your pen and write". I believe they were simply inspired and began to write.

Did you know that there were many prophets who also wrote, but they never got into the canon of Scripture? There were other prophets, and even the Bible refers to some of these prophets, but they are not in the Bible. Their books are not in the Bible because God did not ordain that those books got in the Bible. So Holy men, under the anointing of the Holy Spirit wrote the Word of God and God, supernaturally then allowed those books to singularly continue to be compiled and they never got lost in time. How many have ever lost something? How many have lost something important? I've lost sermons, that's important, but I'm one person and I lost a sermon. And yet God had these men write the Word of God and God preserved it, over thousands of years and never let it get lost and allowed it to be compiled in a Book. And you want to write a book, and look how long it has taken you to say I'm gonna write a book, and you still haven't written it.

But this is God's Book. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man. So the prophetic Word of God didn't come in old times by the will of man, but Holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost. When they were moved to speak they were scribes, and they began to write down what these Holy men were saying or perhaps when they spoke it they wrote it down themselves.

Now lets begin our thought. The Bible says that men of old spoke as they were moved by the Holy Ghost and then it was written down and now we read it. Mortals, just like you and I, wrote the Bible. Mortals that feared and worried and doubted, had struggles, married and had wives and children, took care of kids, changed diapers - mortal men and women. Isaiah burdened for Jerusalem, praying for himself and his sins and the sins of Israel, while under the anointing, said "Behold I show you a sign; A virgin shall conceive". Brother Branham said he probably put his hand over his mouth and said "What did I just say?" Logically Isaiah did not understand that what he had just said. He was being moved and anointed by the Holy Spirit. I'll read it to you.

Isaiah 7 v 13,14. And he said, *Hear ye now O house of David is it a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God*

also? Therefore the Lord Himself shall give you a sign. Behold, a virgin shall conceive and bear a son and shall call His name Immanuel, which being interpreted is God with us.

Thousands of years, 800 years actually, circled the globe. It was never fulfilled in Isaiah's time. People could have risen up and said "Isaiah, you didn't have the mind of Christ". Many probably tried to interpret what he meant by that. Was the virgin Israel? Was it a metaphor, or was it literal? So many times it was a metaphor. So many times it had a shadow, but it had a greater meaning later, but in this case this prophecy was literal, and Isaiah, under the anointing wrote it down.

But as the prophet said, he didn't understand it himself. It never happened in his lifetime. Isaiah died, never seeing hundreds of prophesies, never seeing them fulfilled in his lifetime. Some could have said, well, Isaiah was a false prophet. But everything that he has spoken, that was written in the Word of God, it systematically came to pass, mostly in Jesus' own life and His ministry; His death, His burial and His resurrection and it's coming to pass in our lives today.

How many believe that you are going to be one of those that lie down with the lamb and with the lion? Your children will be able to play on the hole of an asp. I don't understand that, and I don't care if I don't. I just want to be there when it happens, and I don't know how literal the children's part is, it's probably a metaphor. It doesn't matter - it's going to happen. David wrote most of the Psalms while running from Saul, while in distress, while worrying about enemies. Say Amen!

He could have said, I'm really, absolutely caught up in the spirit of worry and doubt and frustration and fretting. Perhaps if you would read the Psalms that's how each one of them start out, but the longer he goes into the Psalm..., remember now, he's got one of his 400 instruments. He's playing those instruments and he's worshipping God, but he starts out saying, 'God, why have you forsaken me? Where are you? Why do my bones stare at me? Why am I going through what I am going through?' He is in perplexity, but he has no idea that while he is singing that Psalm that he is being inspired and his words are a prefigure of what is going to happen to Jesus Christ.

But he doesn't understand that he is God's supernatural person and that it's the supernatural in his life that's motivating him to sing that song, to pen those words, My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken me? He is modelling again; the picture is the Cross. Let's turn in your Bibles and look together. We'll read it in Psalm chapter 22 verse 1 *To the chief musician upon Ai'jeleth Shahaar, A Psalm of David. My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken me?* I don't think David sat there and said, 'you know, I think that's a good tune. I like the way that is kinda flowing. That's going to be really good, write that down.' He was in anguish, just like you, just like me. He was going through doubts and worries and struggles just like you and me. He did not see Himself at that point as being inspired by the pillar of fire, by God Almighty to write this down as a prophetic message for a generation to come. He was writing it down simply to relieve himself, to get into the Spirit, and to seek God.

Psalm 22, v1: *My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me? Why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring?* (Again the picture is the cross,) v7 *All they that see me*

laugh me to scorn, they shoot out the lip, they shake their heads saying; v8 He trusted on the LORD that he would deliver him; let him deliver him, seeing he delighted in him. v9. But thou art he who took me out of the womb; thou didst make me hope when I was upon my mother's breasts. v11. Be not far from me, for trouble is near; for there is none to help. v13. They gaped upon me with their mouths, like a ravening and a roaring lion.

v14. I am poured out like water, ~ This is Jesus. This is Jesus speaking through David. This is the Holy Spirit anointing David to write this about Christ's death. Now Jesus is in the garden. v14 *I am poured out like water and all my bones are out of joint: my heart is like wax; it is melted in the midst of my bowels.* You are about to be crucified. Nails put through your feet and hands, hanging on a cross ~ naked, whipped and beat so badly that you didn't look like a human being. All the beard plucked out of your face. Of course, his heart was melting like wax! But Jesus in the first person did not write this; David wrote it under the anointing of the Holy Spirit.

v15-16 *My strength was dried up like a potsherd and my tongue cleaves to the roof of my jaws; and thou hast bought me into the dust of death. For dogs have compassed me; the assembly of the wicked have enclosed me; they pieced my hands and my feet.* David had no idea what he was saying. I don't think he said "Stop right there, now that's good! I believe that has reference to the Messiah to come. I believe that!" He didn't do that. He was anointed. He was under the anointing of God, he was being supernaturally led, but the part I want you to catch was he didn't know it. His life was supernatural. We know it today because we have the ability to go back 2,800 years and look at his life by way of reference through a Bible, but he didn't have that option; he was merely living out his life as it was happening, had no idea that he was fulfilling the Word of God.

David was just as much a Bible character as you are a Bible character. David was fulfilling his drama for his day. You are fulfilling your drama for your day. Psalm 22 *They pierced my hands and my feet.* Verse 17 *I may tell all my bones, they look and stare upon me.* Verse 18 *They parted my garments among them and cast lots upon my vesture.* Verse 19. *But be not thou far from me O Lord, O my strength, haste thee to help me.* Verse 22 *I will declare thy name unto my brethren; in the midst of the congregation will I praise thee.*

These were all prophetic. That last one you say, well how was that prophetic? Well, Paul the Apostle picks it up in Hebrews doesn't he. And Paul says, David, under the anointing of the Holy Spirit said that Jesus would come and He is not ashamed to call them brethren. So Paul, under the anointing of the Holy Spirit goes back, reads the Psalm and says, wait a minute, that refers to the Church today, that Jesus, the Son of God is not afraid to call us kinsfolk.

So an anointed man almost a thousand years later Paul writes of David and says that it refers to our day. That's Hebrews chapter 2 verse 11 and 12. *My God, My God, why hast thou forsaken me? My bones, they stare at me. They pierced my hands and my feet. They parted my garments and cast lots for my vesture.*

Do you suppose that David then dropped his harp, ran to tell the world that he was just anointed to prophesy about the Messiah? No! He didn't know that what he was doing was Biblical. He

didn't know that it would be put into spiritual cannon of the Word of God and that thousands and millions and billions of people will read it. Had he known he would not have been walking by faith, there you are. But he didn't know, David didn't know that it was prophetic. David didn't know that he was moved of God to speak about Christ's crucifixion David, listen, watch the atmosphere; he was in prayer, he was making music, he was meditating, he was needy, he was seeking God and in that atmosphere he became inspired by God to write a Psalm. You say, 'Brother Jeff, can we duplicate that?' That's what I'm trying to tell you. You are just as much a prophetic people as David was. You are just as much a Bible character as David was. You are just as much a part of the Book, and came out of this Book as David did, as Moses and Abraham. You are just as much written epistles read and known of all men as those men were as well.

You are this Book made flesh!

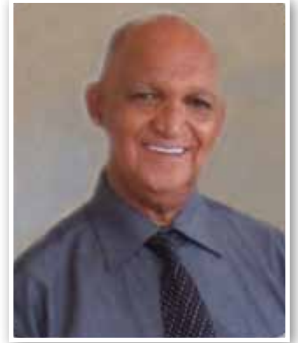
