Testimony Of A Youth

Dear brothers and sister, I want to tell you about the amazing grace of our Lord Jesus Christ.

As it started I was an unfaithful Roman Catholic wallowing in sin thinking I was going to heaven. Throughout my life I felt something within me, a thirst for the real God. But I didn't know who he was, or that he was a healer or savior.

When I was 17 something happened that changed the whole course of my life. One morning in school, the devil put a thought in my head that I was a homosexual, and I am ashamed to be identified with the word. But for the next 8 months the devil tried to make that thought conceive, but by the grace of God it didn't, and I thank and praise him for it.

I found the only safe place from such spirits is in the arms of Jesus Christ, because you are fighting with demonic spirits and your flesh cannot handle it. It takes the Hand of Almighty God.

Being unsaved at the time, I would pray in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost, asking him to deliver me. At one point in my prayers I said "Lord, if you'll deliver me, I'll read your Bible and serve you" As time passed, the Lord delivered me, but I was still not serving Him. Constant pressure from this perverted spirit

brought me to read the Bible. Although I didn't understand much, I got comfort from reading it, and my heart would burn. When we start to lose that burning, that's when we could get down on our knees and cry out to the Lord, like David

to come to life. Although others disagreed, I still believed it, Praise be to God. About this time my older brother and younger sister were getting involved in some new religion. I didn't know it was the old though, and I wasn't



did; "Lord restore unto me the Joy of Thy Salvation". I believe Jesus Christ is the author and finisher of our faith, God wants us to be totally dependent upon Him. As the Bible said "casting all your cares upon Him for he careth for you".

The first thing I came across in the Bible that I understood and believed was when Jesus said, "whosoever looks upon a woman to lust, hath committed adultery with her in his heart". The seed in me had just been watered and was starting

really getting involved, but after talking to my sister sometime later, I got excited and wanted to find out more. She told me to talk to a brother in our church. About 1 month later, the day after my graduation from high school, my brother, Richard came over and showed me a paper called "The Lord God Hath Spoken". It spoke about the message of the hour by Bro. Branham. There was something in there, that spoke to me real loud. It was about the revealing of what 666 was. There

was a line that read, "Are you a part of the system 666, denominationalism or a part of the body of Christ?" I wanted to talk to my brother more about this, so I made arrangements to go over to his place later that week to talk. When I went there, I saw Wayne whom I had met a few times before. Him and my brother shook hands, called each other "brother" and started talking to me about the Lord (for about 8 hours). At the close of the evening they finished by letting Wayne read to me the story "Footprints". This made tears come to my eyes, for I knew that during all I had went through for 8 months, (when I felt there was no escape and that suicide was the best way), The Lord was there and He was carrying me, through it all.

I went to my first service the following Sunday at the Endtime Message Tabernacle, Bro. Harold Hildebrandt was preaching a sermon called "Satans Eden". Experiencing the presence of the Lord for the first time was awesome. The following Sunday I got baptized and after the service I said to Wayne, "The water they baptized me in was dirty", he said in response, "It was a whole lot dirtier when you came out!" Amen! Thank the Lord, Jesus Christ has forgiven me from all of my sins.

I realized later that I was now in a battle and not a picnic. The battle is

A Healing Testimony, from Debbie Smith

testimony that should be shared with as many people as possible.

The Lord has brought me through several major operations when I was very close to death.

At the age of 14 months old, the doctors told my parents that I had a rare disease which consists of a type of disease which consists of a type cancer, known as "Hemangeomas". During this time, tissue blisters were forming on the right side of my

head, and the blisters would burst causing a great loss of blood. The hemangeomas are also known as misplaced blood vessels. Due to the rapid blood flow, at the age of 14 months old, my heart had enlarged to the size of a 6 years old child's heart. The blood flow also caused my right ear to form to the size of an adults ear. The doctors told my parents that the pressure of the blood would cause my heart to burst if my right ear wasn't removed. So at the age of 3 my ear was taken off. Since

then, I have had over 25 operations on my head alone. For 7 years the doctor thought my condition had gotten better. But, in the winter of 1982 and Spring of 1983, I had 3 more surgeries because other hemangeomas were located.

At the age of 5 years old, I was having difficulty with seeing out of my left eye. So my parents had me examined by an eye doctor who said I was completely blind in that eye. My mom heard of Pentecostal evangelist

who was going to be holding services at a nearby church, and also having a healing service. That night, both my parents took me there and the evangelist called my mom from her seat and told her a of rare blood condition she had. This gave her faith enough to ask him to pray for me. He did, and then he asked me to cover my good eye, and to look at him, with my blind eye and tell him how many fingers he was holding up. I could see his fingers and count them, and I read a sign

that was hanging over the church door. My parents took me back to my doctor who cried and said, "This is definitely a miracle!"

When I was 7 years old, the Lord brought me through another major operation that was done on my kidney. I was told that my left kidney was no longer functioning, and 3/4 of it was blocked off. In December of 1983, which was 10 years later; I went for another kidney examination. When the results came

back, the doctors said both of my kidneys were in perfect functioning condition, including the 3/4 part which had been blocked off.

I believe you all can see how the Lord has delivered me from deaths doors so many times, and if it weren't for his mercy, I wouldn't be alive today!

Though I went through all of what I did, I felt in my heart that the Lord had a reason for it all happening.

I wasn't a Christian until the age of 13, when we had our first Youth Camp in West Milton, Ohio. It was an experience I'll never forget! Brother Jeff Jenkins was preaching on the first night, and everything he spoke on hit me. I fought back the

tears during the whole service. Then an altar call was given, and I must have been the last young person up there because Satan kept telling me, "You don't need that!" But there was another voice saying, "You do need that!" That's when I went, and the Lord did the rest. I haven't been the same since.

Sure, I have my problems, and the devil is constantly fighting.

But there's an even bigger power that gets me through those trials. I thank the Lord for all I've gone through, only because it's made me stronger.

I just want to share with all of the young people around the world, that Jesus is still healing and delivering the sick, because I'm a living witness of that!

"And talking to--in the room yesterday where some young Christians was, I said, if you were standing out here on the road and a car was coming down the road at ninety miles an hour, out of control, you would get off that highway as quick as you could. You'd jump, slide, do anything, to get out of the way of that car. And that's the way that sin should be to a Christian, because sin is associated with death. And as soon as you see sin in any form, jump from it, get away from it. I don't care what you have to do, get away from the very appearance of evil. Because remember to associate with sin is death. Just the same as standing there and let that car strike you.

Don't just wait and see what it'll do; get out of the way of it. The very appearance of evil, shun it quickly. When you see a temptation coming up, and sin. . . You know, if it's something wrong, that death is lurking after you. See? Then get away from it just as

quick as you would get away from an automobile approaching at ninety miles an hour. See? You'd want to get away from it right quick, out of the way. Jump, slide, run anyway, just get away from it.

And how that we know that we have life, is because that we hate sin. And we hate sin so bad, that we know that death's associated there, and we shun the very appearance of it. Anyway we can get away from it, we jump, run, anything that we can do to keep away from sin, because sin has death in it, and we sure don't want to associate anything in death. We want to keep away from that.

So I thought that would be a good little thought. It struck me yesterday talking to these Christians; and I thought that would be good to pass to the church this morning, especially while the young people are setting here and undergo--such temptations at that."

Almost Is No Fun



There is no commission on the sale you most make, no fun on the trips you almost take, and no security in the promotion you most get. There is no thrill in almost doing anything. Columbus did not discover America by traveling almost the whole way. He had to make the entire trip in order to achieve his discovery. It has been over time and time again that in business school or any other part of your natural life, putting your all into something is bound to get good results. The difference in the grade of test that you studied for and the grade of test that you hardly studied for is enormous. The point that I'm trying to make is that the result from something you give 100% to are much different than something you almost give 100% to. Let's move on now and talk about our Christian walk.

Brother Jeff Jenkins of Lima, Ohio once said while preaching, "The half-way Christian is the

most miserable person in the world." Why is the statement so true? Because it is impossible to have a victorious Christian walk if we are only living half or even 99% of the word so graciously given for us to live by today. In 2nd Kings 10:30 and 31, a good example is shown of someone who only gave himself half-heartedly to the Lord.

30—And the Lord said unto Jehu, because thou hast done well in executing that which is right in mine eyes, and hast done unto the house of Ahab according to all that was in mine heart, thy children of the fourth generation shall sit on the throne of Israel.

31—But Jehu who took no heed to walk in the law of the Lord God of Israel with all his heart: for he departed not from the sins of Jeroboam, which made Israel to sin.

Jehu (even after God blessing him), wouldn't give a total 100% of his heart to the Lord. He still had a part of the

world that he was hanging on to. I hope your getting the idea of what God really wants in His people. God is looking for a total commitment. Let's go into that a little bit more.

According to Webster, "total" means, "the whole amount." Our entire body, soul and spirit should be sold out to Him. What if Noah would have built the ark in his spare time? It wouldn't have worked. Noah had to sell-out totally to what God had said to do. He was totally committed to the message of that day. And what about Noah's kids? What about Noah's kids, kids? Don't you think they went through teenage troubles? Don't you think they took persecution for believing the message their father and prophet had brought? Do you think the pressures got to them enough to make them have little thoughts of doubt sometimes? Do you think they were laughed at and made fun of? That message was preached an entire 120

years before it became a reality. Some of us are falling apart after just 21 years. But there was something down in those young men and women's hearts that made them sell out 100% to what they believed in. There was no "almost living it" involved. They suffered through the persecution, committed themselves totally to God and as a result, were saved. Sure 120 years was a long time but, it paid off in the end. And I can't even imagine what it was like to be safe inside the ark, with the storm raging on the outside. When I penned this little article, I began to think of all the young people that I have been privileged enough to meet in my life. I am excited to see the growth and maturity that has taken place recently in the hearts of young people all over. It's exciting to hear that the young people from Murphysboro, Tennessee are having a revival and are still on fire for God since Youth Camp "84" in July

Questions and Answers

Answers are taken from Brother William Branham's messages.

Q. (1) At what age should a young person be baptized?

Answer: Just as soon as you can. Q. (2) Will all the young people of true, born again believers be saved?

Answer: No, brother; no they sure won't. See, as I copied David DuPlessis on this remark, "God don't have grandchildren, just sons and daughters." See they'll have to be born just exactly like their father and mother was born of the Spirit.

Q. (3) Knowing that time is ending and eternity setting in, what would be your advice for a couple planning marriage?

Answer: Go right ahead and get married; See, go right on just like if you was going to live for another hundred years here on earth. Just go right on; keep your heart set on Christ, not your hearts on these things of the World, but on Christ.

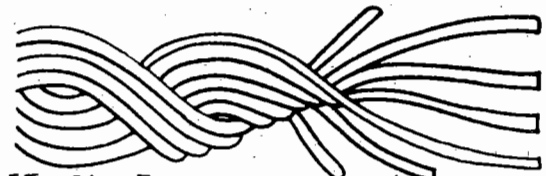

asked him, "Is it true that Jesus and the Father are one?" And he answered, "Yes, they are one." (see John 10:30). Then he told us to close our eyes and he started praying in a language I cannot understand. When we opened our eyes, there was a great darkness and I saw a small light. The pastor explained that the darkness represents the evildoers and the small light stands for a very few people to be saved (Matt. 22:14). And he that was in the pulpit shouted "Go everyone of you!" The people did not understand his word before he left; but I rushed out of the meeting house and the people were left inside. I wasn't far from the place when one exclaimed, "A fire! The building is on fire!" I did not look back as I was afraid that I would become a pillar of salt just what happened to Lot's wife (Gen. 19:26). Though I wasn't looking behind, I saw how the fire consumed and destroyed the whole building and the people in it who did not follow what the minister

had commanded them to do.

When I awoke from the dream, I cried and thanked Jesus Christ for a great revelation He gave me. Here I am rejoicing, for the Lord called me and I recognized His voice. As it is written in John 10:27, "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me."

Now I know I'm one of His sheep and that Jesus Christ is the Almighty God and in Him is our salvation.

There was a tremendous turnout of youth from the U. S., Canada, and also from other foreign countries. Even though there were many of us who had never met them before, there was a feeling of

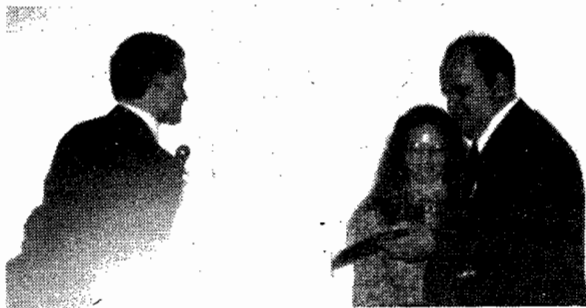

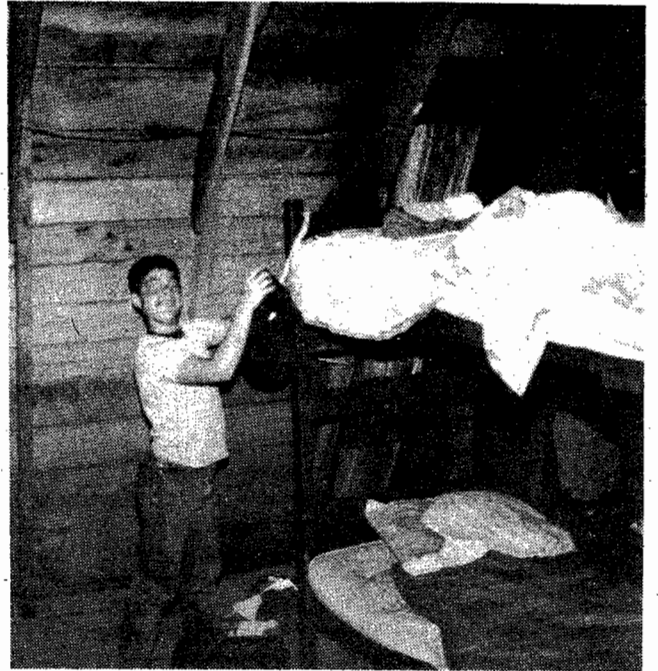

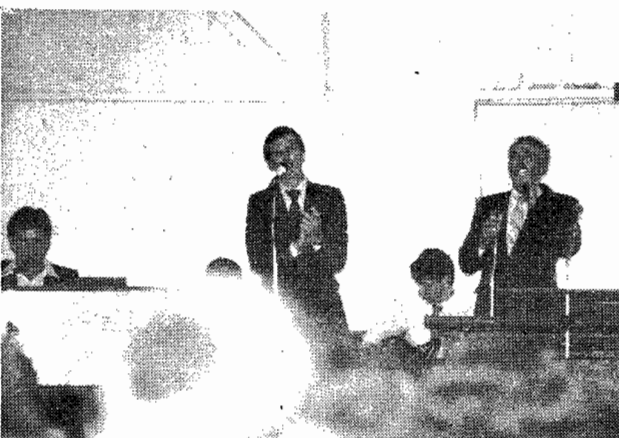

Parson to Person

Our parson to person for this issue is our Brother Daniel Williams. Brother Daniel is the grandson of Brother Carl Williams, of whom Brother Branham often spoke about. Brother Carl was treasurer of the Full Gospel Business Mens Fellowship International and also the founder and president of the Phoenix chapter. As he relates his testimony, try to apply his experiences (good and bad) to your own life. Find that God has a plan for everyone of His children, and that no matter how many battles and struggles we must go thru We've been made more than conquerors in Christ Jesus.

In 1952 my grandfather, Carl E. Williams, had been an arthritic invalid for twelve years. At this time he decided to attend one of Brother William Branham's meetings in Phoenix, Arizona. Grand-dad entered the service on crutches, taking only three inch steps. After Brother Branham had prayed for him, he dropped the crutch one way and the other crutch the other way. He left the meeting taking three feet steps per stride!

Four years later on February 24th, 1956, I was born in Cottonwood, Arizona. I was the youngest of three children. Even though my parents were not Christians at the time, they had enough respect for grand-dad that they would attend a service whenever grand-dad would invite them, (no questions asked). In 1961 they both went to Miami, Florida where they were to attend some meetings there that grand-dad had invited them to go to. One certain night, dad was on the fifth floor of a hotel,

in a mens prayer meeting and mom was on the third floor in a ladies prayer meeting. Before leaving the prayer services that night, they received the gift of the Holy Ghost.

When they returned home from those meetings, the T. V. went out one door and the tape recorder came in the other. I was only five years old at the time, but I still remember the reel to reel tapes of Brother Branham's voice filling the rooms of our home. Along with this, many other changes took place as my parents began their christian walk with the Lord.

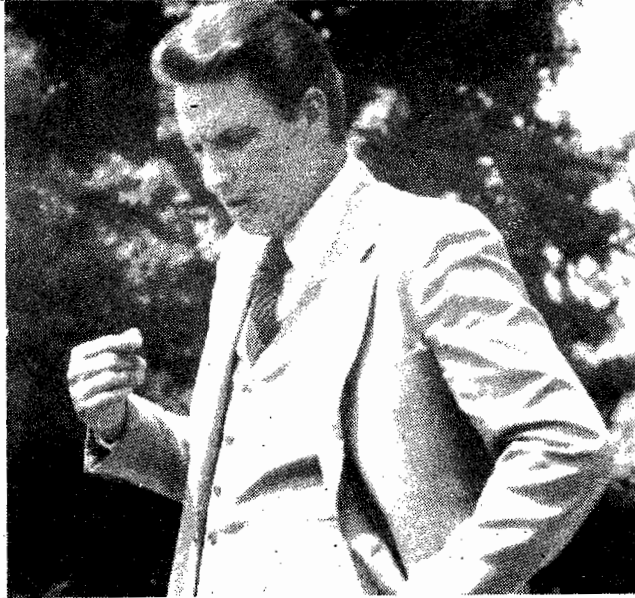
From the time I can remember, I was always in church. After my grandfather's healing in 1952, anytime Brother Branham came to the Phoenix area, my family was there. When I was seven or eight years old, I attended some children's meetings of the Full Gospel Business Mens Fellowship International (F. G. B. M. F. I.). They asked for anyone wanting the Holy Ghost to come forward. I went up front and after much encouragement I said some words (that they were wanting me to say) and everyone began telling me that I had the Holy Ghost. The only problem was that there was no change in my life.

I also remember being in one of Brother Branham's services in California, when I was only about eight years old. The mikes were not working correctly and after about twenty minutes of it, Brother Branham stepped to the side of the pulpit and said, "I'm a small man, but I pack a big Message." I will never forget that, it made such an impact on my life.

The last time I remember seeing Brother Branham, was at his apartment in Tucson, Arizona. It was in late '65' and our family had taken some fruit to him. I stayed in the car and they went to the door. Then after a while Brother Branham came outside. I was only nine

pastoring.

In 1968 I attended a youth camp on top of Mount Lemon, near Tucson, Arizona. An outstanding thing took place that I'll never forget. I had known a young man who had come to youth camp with the intention of committing suicide. His life



years old at the time, but I still remember thinking to myself how much of a gentleman he was. He was always so kind and considerate. The day we received the news that Brother Branham had died, was the darkest day of my life. Although I was not living for the Lord at the time, I knew life would not be the same without this great prophet in our midst.

Up until 1964 my family was attending the First Assembly of God church in Phoenix, Arizona. After the Assembly of God church refused to let Brother Branham preach for them any longer, Dad told them we would not be back. We then started attending a message church. It was in Mesa, Arizona where Brother Roy Carpenter is still

was racked with pain and he was in alot of trouble with the law. It was a great camp and the Lord was really moving. The last night of the camp there was a great moving of the Holy Ghost. Many of us were in the altar and along with us was this young man. Though many of us did not receive a life changing experience, this young man did. That night God filled that desperate heart with the Holy Ghost and he lived a victorious life from that night even until this very day!

In 1970 I started riding bulls because I always wanted to be in the rodeos. I loved the outdoors and the cowboy life. But along with that life came other things too. It was then that I started chewing

tobacco and drinking alcohol. There was always plenty of it around the rodeos for us to have. All this time I was still attending church on a regular basis, but I just could not live the life. Whenever the Holy Ghost would move I would get under great conviction and go the altar. Things would be alright for a few days but then the pull of the world would pull me down again.

Later that year, I was in Tucson, Arizona, fellowshiping with some of the young people from Tucson Tabernacle. We were having a singing around a campfire. It was that night that I first met a beautiful young girl by the name of Melody Barker, who was later to become Mrs. Daniel Williams.

In 1971 my family moved to Tucson, Arizona and we began attending the Tucson Tabernacle. There were several of us young boys in the church who would run around together. We knew how to live but were unconverted so we could not live it. During the ages from 15 to 18 my parents were constantly praying for me. I didn't know it at the time but there was someone else praying too. It was that beautiful girl I had met at age 14. I found out later that Melody had been praying for me all along.

During these years in Tucson I was still very much involved in rodeos. I traveled all over the state riding in junior rodeo competitions. It was my ambition to make a career of it. Also during this time I was seeing more and more of Melody. She represented to me that which was pure and Godly. She had received the Holy Ghost when she was five years old and lived a very

consecrated life. I knew she was the girl I wanted, but I just felt so unworthy. Finally I asked her to marry me and she agreed to, if her father would agree to it. It was about six months later that I finally got up enough courage to ask Brother Barker. It had to be the most difficult thing I have ever done in my life, but thanks be to God, he said Yes.

In 1973 while working as a carpenter in Tucson. I was cutting with a skill saw when it kicked back on me and buried itself in my leg. The wound got staff infection and I spent the next three months in the hospital. During this time the Lord was dealing with me very strongly. I did alot of praying and soul searching, but still there was no total surrender.

In December of 1973 we were having special meetings at the tabernacle. The Holy Spirit was moving greatly and I went to the altar and began to cry out to God. I went on and was baptized during those meetings. I had felt the reality of God and could never be satisfied until I went on to receive the baptism of the Holy Ghost.

On August 30th, 1974 we were married. They say that marriage settles you down and I thought that after I was married I would be able to live the life for Melody's sake. But within a few weeks I found myself going back to the old life. Even though I was married to the most wonderful girl in the world and one who was a great christian, without Jesus Christ in my own life I could not live a holy life.

On December 31st, 1974 my father-in-law told us of some meetings in Beaumont, Texas. He encouraged us to go and so in a desperate attempt to find the peace of God, we decided to go. On January 1st, 1975 at 7:00

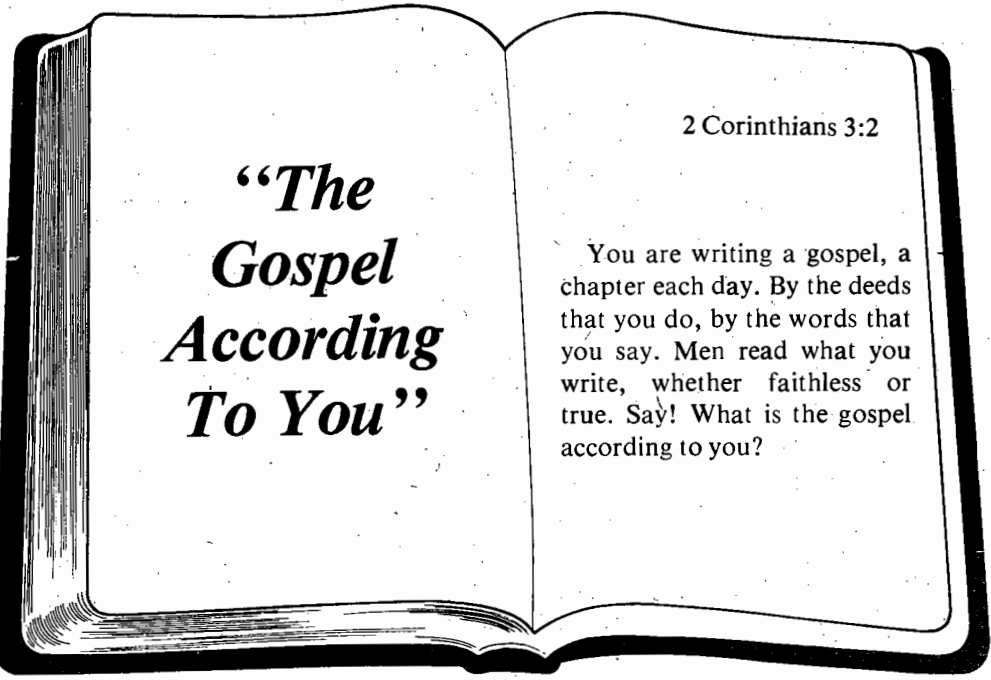
Alex Eyre—"In Good Hands"

o'clock A. M. on the third floor of a motel room in Beaumont, Texas I finally reached a place of total surrender. I told the Lord that if I never spoke in tongues or had any of the gifts, that would be just fine. 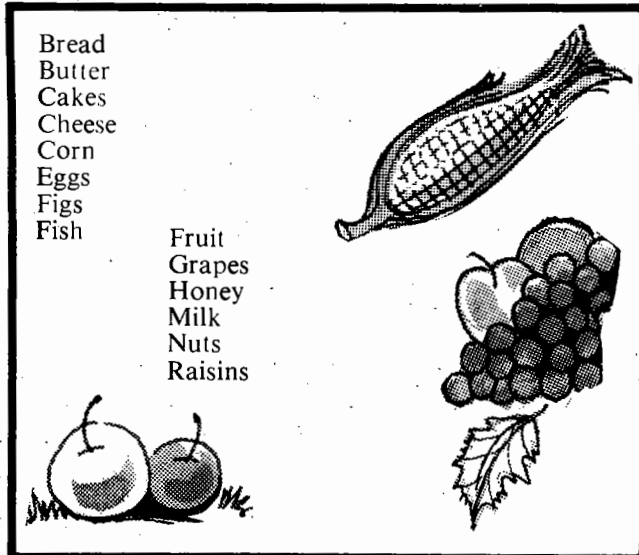

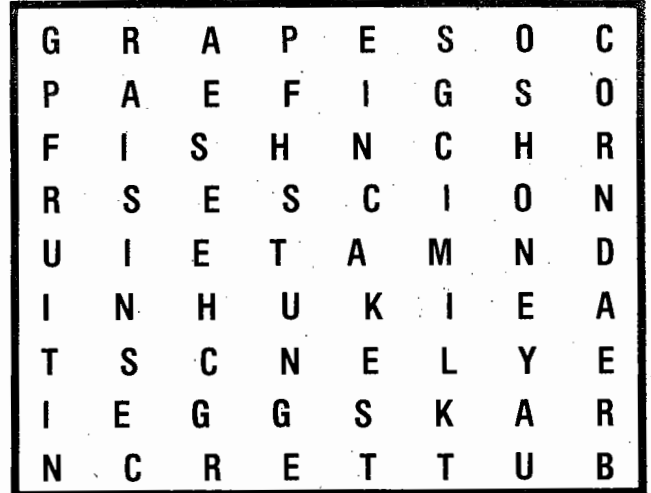
