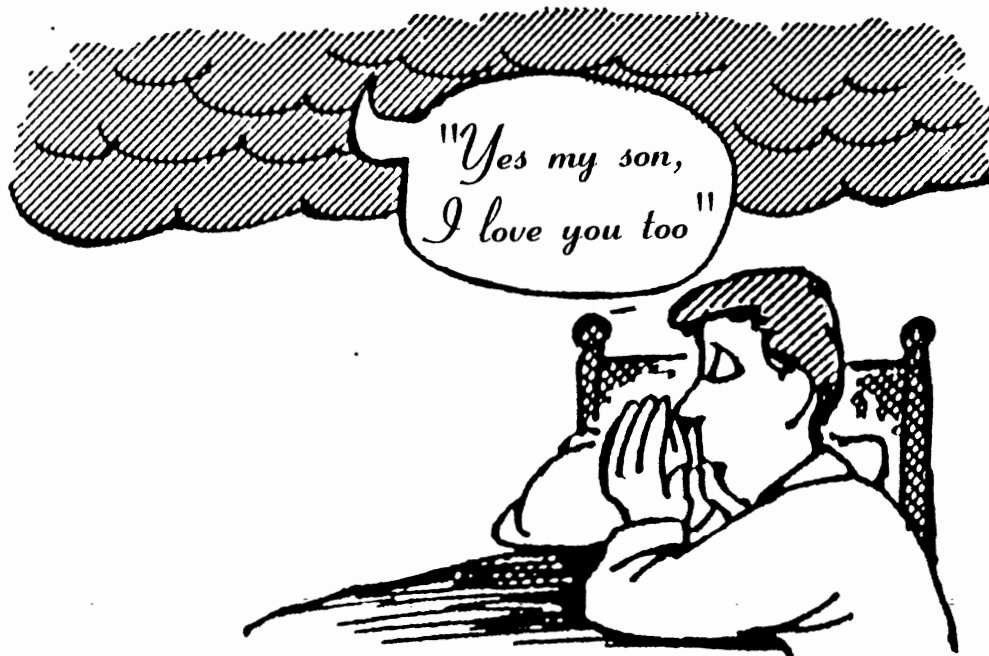

I've just realized how easy it is to have fun, I mean real fun, but "Camping" is not just fun, its an inward satisfaction especially when it's showered with worship, preaching, teachings, sing-a-long-songs, pacifying testimonies, heart to heart laughter and just doing what you love doing most.

FRIDAY EVENING

The first night wasn't of a usual practice to us, like it has been for many of you

ALL THAT GLITTERS IS NOT GOLD

In The Harvest Time, preached in Phoenix, beginning at Paragraph 151, Bro. Branham tells the story of a trapping technique he used to catch raccoons when he was a boy. As the story goes, he would find a hollow log near a creek where he knew a raccoon had been running. He bores a hole in the log, and hangs some shiny object (in this case, a tobacco twist tag) inside the hollow log so it can be seen through the bored hole. Around the edge of the bored hole, he drives several nails, angling them toward the center, so that a coon's empty hand can easily slip through the hole and grasp the shiny object. But with a clenched fist around the object, his hand won't slip back through the hole. The nature of the raccoon will not permit him to release the shiny object to free himself from the trap. All he has to do to go free is let go of the shiny object. If he refuses to let go before the trapper returns, it certainly means death.

Don't get trapped by the things of the world! The farther we remove ourselves from the world and what it has to offer, we see what an awful condition it's in. It is easy for us to see that hell has enlarged itself and the world is falling apart all around us. As Christians, we know that before too long, this world will be destroyed, and neither root nor branch will be left. So be careful to avoid the devil's many invitations. But if we are not careful, we choose, without thinking, to become entangled in something that the devil dangles in front of us.

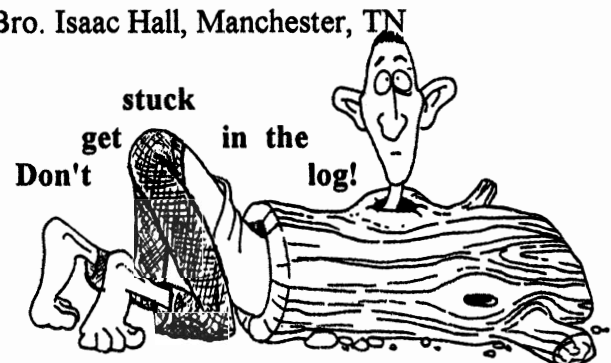
Before we realize what has happened, we come out from behind The Fortified Word of God, like Eve did in the Garden, and reach out for some "shiny object" with which the devil entices us. On page 16 of The World is Falling

Apart, Bro. Branham says, "You went out after him. He never came in and got you. Cause, 'you are dead and your life is hid in God, and is sealed by the Holy Ghost.' The only way he could ever get in there, is the same way you did. So he just invited you, and you walked out to him. That's all." The devil will lay some shiny object out there for you, and, unless you hold onto God's Word, he'll have you in a trap before you know it. Once he gets you trapped, he will tell you that there is no hope for you and that you never were intended to be one of God's children anyway.

But just as we chose to grab for the glitter of the world, we can choose to return to God. He is waiting for us where we left Him. All we have to do is let go. Some may choose to hold on. But remember: one day, the hunter comes.... So, as Paul says, "Let us lay aside every weight that so easily besets us, and press toward the mark for the prize of the High Calling of God in Christ Jesus."

Let's pray that we never become as stubborn as the raccoon. The end is near and the devil is trying to get you any way he can. If there is any part of you that is holding onto the world, LET GO NOW!!! Don't let the devil get you in a trap. Just hold on to God's Word and stand on His Promises. I know that it's difficult to resist the temptations of this world in the age we now live, but the Bible says that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared to the glory that shall be revealed in us. So let us stand on every promise in the Book, and fight against the powers of hell. The battle is almost over.

our spiritual hunger pangs, with his first basic teaching meeting entitled (**'ME, SPECIAL ME'**), breaking down all belittling barriers we build in our lives, because of not appreciating and realizing what a special people we are, but restoring confidence and showing us how much God loves us, cares for us, and just how special we are.

by another breath and soul taking service on "OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH OTHERS; THE IMPORTANCE OF AUTHORITY and topping it with THE AGE OF ACCOUNTABILITY".

Meeting God's authority is not easy for many young people, because we are easily distracted, and attracted to the things of the world, but we learned that obedience is better than sacrifice and the Lord fulfilled a perfect type, when He learned obedience through things He suffered.

As we addressed the thought on the age of accountability and full maturity, which seemed to baffle the minds of many young people, we actually found out in the book of Numbers 14:29, that the age of total maturity is taken from 20 years upwards **SURPRISE,**

SURPRISE. As the end of the evening was upon us, we were entertained to snacks, chats, and sing-a-longs.

SUNDAY MORNING

Early birds arose and shone, followed by up a mountain devotion, later topped with breakfast. By 10:30 am we were all set and waiting for the last but not least of our portion.

THE CLIMAX : YOUR TEMPTATIONS' RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD.

The message on temptations really stirred up the hearts of many, leaving us confident, secured and sheltered by the **BLOOD.** When we learned that God has great confidence in us, and by that He allows burdens and temptations to

GET ALONG ABILITY PART 2

A STRONGER RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Luke 2:52 says that as Jesus was growing up he *"Increased in wisdom and stature and in favor with God and Man."* All of us should desire such a life as this, especially when we are a young person. Jesus' relationship with God and others strengthened as he grew. This is so different from what we see in youth today. It seems youths get along worse-n-worse with everybody instead of better and better. They also tend to drift away from a close walk with God. Satan and the spirit of this age bring this kind of result in young people. God's kingdom calls for a much higher way to live than this. That is why we desire to share some helpful guidelines in this issue and the next to make our relationships better. In this article we'll deal with our relationship with God. To draw closer to Him is the most important thing in our life.

I want to make it clear first that the nature you were born with will never get along with God. People try so hard to have some kind of harmony and fellowship with Him when they haven't had a change of nature. In the "Inner Veil", 1956, Brother Branham said, "You in your condition, never get along. You can't get along with your wife. You can't get along with your husband, can't get along with your neighbor. How are you ever going to get along with God? So He has to give you a new spirit, so you can get along with Him."

There has to be a change first. God desires fellowship. Revelation 3:20 says *"Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him and will sup with him, and he with me."* If He is going to sup with us, that means



fellowship or communion. Notice also that He desires to sup with the individual because He said *"if any man"* God never wanted to fellowship with whole churches. He wanted fellowship with you as an individual, personally. There should be no distance between us and Him. Our best friend in the world should be Jesus Christ. As I said, He certainly deserves our fellowship, but I want to ask you this. What starts fellowship with God? Before we can have fellowship or strengthen it, we must know how fellowship starts.

AN EXPERIENCE

Before anyone can fellowship with God, they must have an initial experience. The Bible calls this experience a New Birth. (John 3:1-7) There's no other place for fellowship with God except through the shed blood of Jesus Christ. You must have an experience with the living God of this hour. A revelation of Jesus Christ personally to you, that's the New Birth. The foundation of a strong relationship with God is a New Birth experience. What does it mean to be born again? It's very simple. It requires us to die. Not that we fall over dead, but the nature inside us that loves the world has to die. This is the experience of the New Birth. You cannot fake a New Birth. That won't work. There must be a real dying out to yourself. If I can give you a simple key word to the New Birth... it's the word yield. That is how a person dies out to themselves; By yielding to God. Romans 6:11-19 says, *"Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lust thereof. Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under grace. What then? shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under grace? God forbid. Know ye not, that to whom ye*

yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that ye were the servants of sin, but ye have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, ye became the servants of righteousness. I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness." Ask yourself this. When God asked me to do something, am I willing to do it??? Can you yield to Him no matter what He asks??

I want to explain what happens when God begins to lead you to a New Birth. I'm sure this is feeble compared to what some of the better qualified ministers that are reading could do. Nevertheless, I'll try.

God begins working on your heart. Your heart begins to get tender toward God. All of a sudden you become aware that you need God. You start thinking about Him. It doesn't have anything to do with your parents. This is God beginning to deal with you. At this point, it is so important how you respond to all of this. Bro. Branham said in "Believing God", 1952, "And the only thing that kept me from being saved when I was twelve years old, because a spirit hung over me, a devil, saying, 'wait a little longer...' That's the reason you wasn't saved when you became the age of accountability. A spirit, you got in a crowd, and that hovered over you and kept hanging over you. You wanted to do right. There is not a man that's got his right mind but what wants to do right, but there is something that won't let you do right."

HOW DO I YIELD?

So many have complicated the way to know God. It's not complicated, but you do have to give yourself totally up. When God begins to speak to you just simply yield to it. Many young people do not know how to yield. Here are some thoughts to help you yield to God.

1. Forget what everyone else is thinking about you.

2. Go against the grain. Do the opposite of what reasoning tells you.

3. Be willing to give up things that God asks you to; Even if it hurts a little.

4. Lay down your rights at the altar.

5. Be honest with God.

6. Don't try to figure out what's happening to you, just follow His leading.

7. Worship God in the services with all your might.

8. Keep your mind on the good things God has done.

God deals in a very personal way with each of us. In the story of the rich young ruler, we find him wanting eternal life. He was a good kid, but still wanted more. Jesus didn't come to him. The rich young ruler came to Jesus. He told Jesus he had obeyed all the commandments from his youth, but he probed Jesus to find out what more he must do. The Lord then put his finger on an area of his life that he knew would be hard to give up. God does not do this to be mean, but He knows if a person gives up that which is dear to him, then he or she means business with God. They really do want more of God. In a loving way, He'll ask you to give up things that you never thought he was concerned about. He's doing it for a reason. That's what dying means in the Bible.

A New Birth experience with God is an experience of dying to ourselves. If you can have a receiving or welcome type of heart toward the Word in your early walk with God, it will help you more in the future. Jesus needs an agreeable spirit. Bro. Branham said in "Souls in Prison Now", 1963, "If He can only get that Nature of that spirit to agree with Him, then that Nature dies. The Nature and the love of the world dies and the things of the world is dead; because if you love the world or the things of the world, the Love of God is not in you." Now lets look further into a strong walk with God.

who fell because she could be tempted.

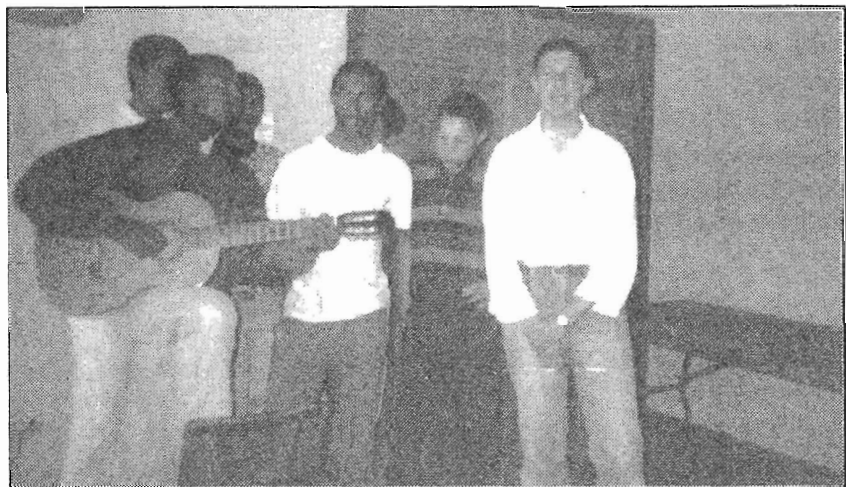

Brother Branham describes this perfectly by this story.

Ghost. Said, 'there's been two dogs in me. One of them is an evil dog, and one of them is a good dog. And they just fuss and fight all the time.' And said Chief, 'which one overcomes?' He said, 'well it depend on which one the Chief feeds the most.'"

That sounds to me like a great key to strengthen our relationship with God. Starve the bad dog and feed the good dog. Take a pen right now and write down a huge list of things that you know in your life are feeding the bad dog. I believe it will help you see just how much he's still getting fed. Maybe that's why you can't seem to get stronger.

To end this article, I leave you with some scriptures and some things to do to help you draw

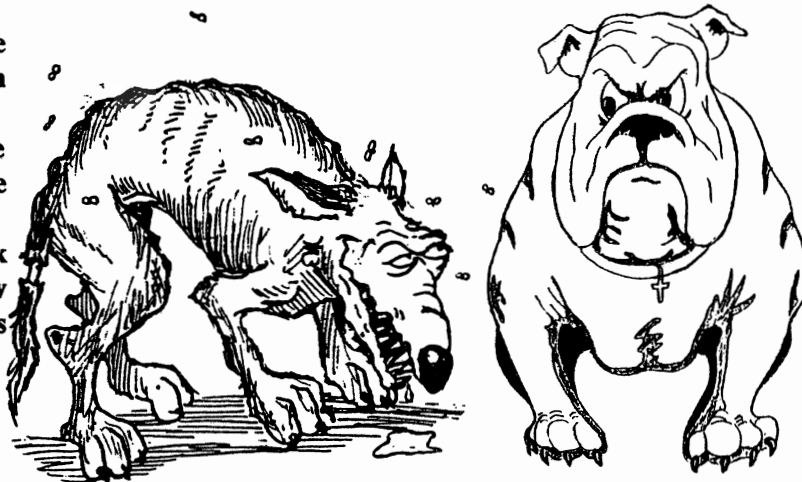
closer to the Lord. These points were suggested by young people just like you in our local assembly. I'm happy to share them with you. Till next issue, May God Bless you.

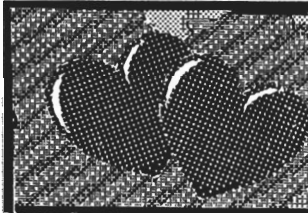
