REPORT ON LOUISIANA SPRING CAMP ADDII 13-16

Spring Camp in Louisiana wasn't just another camp for many people. It was a life changing experience. One young person said, "Straight forward preaching brought me to a reality." What kind of reality? The fact that the Holy Spirit is not some farout

unattainable thing that only parents, pastors, and different people other than we can have.

Brother Paul LaFontaine was the night speaker and preached on the Holy Ghost. God moved to bring Truth and expose the deception Satan puts in our minds.

Brother Paul said Satan tricks us into thinking the Holy Ghost is some deep dark secret, or on the other extreme tries to give you a confidence you have it when you don't just to keep you from it. Our brother left us with some checks to identify the Holy Spirit in our lives. He said we must have distinctions different from the world, rest or peace as God has promised, power to be a witness, to not be ashamed God. boldness for humbleness towards God and man. and to be a willing empty vessel that God can use.

He identified several issues where Satan fights young people. I realized how much pressure is put on young people associated with the End Time Message from spirits of the world. GETALONGABILITY PART I

LOOKING AT YOURSELF FIRST

Hey, How are you doing horizontally? That may seem like a crazy question. I'll put it a little more clear so you know what I mean. How well are you getting along with those around you? Bad or Good? Maybe you get along pretty good with your buddies, but do you get along with your parents? In the next three issues of Youth Quake, we want to talk about "Getalongability".

We want to learn about ways to improve our relationship with those around us (horizontal) and our relationship with God (vertical). So now when I ask, "How are you vertically?" you'll understand what I mean.

There is a really good scripture to use as a starting point for this subject. Luke 2:52 says, "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and man." Not too many scriptures tell about the growing up years with Jesus. Yet, the ones that do speak volumes. Jesus did have to grow up too.. He was a

baby. He was a child. He was even a teenager, like you. More than anything, He was our ultimate example to follow.

This scripture says two things were going on as Jesus grew. "He increased in wisdom and stature." and "He increased in favor with God and man."

His relationship with God and others improved and strengthened as he grew up. That's what we want, don't we? We want favor with God and those around us.

Jesus' horizontal and vertical relationships got better and better not worse and worse. What a great life to live and I believe you can live it too.

Look in the Mirror

Before we learn some things in part two and three about improving our getalongability, let's look at ourselves first. You may say..,"I don't get along with some people because of the way they are. They never do things my way." It's obvious in these statements that the problem is with yourself, not

others.

Getting along with others starts with us having getalongability <u>first</u>. Even with our fellowship with the Lord, we can't blame Him for not being close to us. We must draw close to Him. James 4:8 says, "Draw nigh to God and He will draw nigh to you."

Why don't you look in the mirror a minute? Get a piece of paper and pen. Take the questions below and write them down. Then... write out complete answers to each one. This will help take a good look at yourself.



- 1. How are you vertically (how close is your relationship with God)?
- 2. How much do you read your Bible and the Messages and listen to the Message tapes?
- 3. How often do you pray?
- 4. Is there anything you do that you know weakens your fellowship with God? What is it?
- 5. How are you horizontally (how close is your relationship with those around you)?
- 6. How close are you to your parents? If not close, explain why?
- 7. What things do you know you could do to get closer to your parents?

- 8. How well do you get along with your brothers and sisters?
- 9. What things do you do that cause arguments or contention with others?
- 10. Are you content with your physical features?
- 11. What do you like about the way you look? What don't you like?
- 12. What do you like about your personality? What don't you like?
- 13. How do you think others see you as a person?
- 14. How do you think God sees you as a person?

Now, look at all your answers one more time. Some of them should show that you can get along better with others when you change a little yourself. You could very well be the one making it difficult to get along with everybody. Maybe you need to ask God to change you in some areas of your life.

A person said to me one time, "I don't seem to have any friends and I can't seem to get close to anybody." My answer to that was Proverbs 18:24, "A man that hath friends must show himself friendly..."

It really doesn't matter what others are doing to make it difficult to get along. What matters is the life we live. Are we friendly? Do we give love out, even when there is no guarantee of it being returned? That's what Christ has done for us. Shouldn't we live the same way?

Looking Into Another Mirror

There is one more thing I would like to add to looking at yourself. As Jesus grew up, He learned more and more of who He was in God's eyes. He began to see His purpose in the Word of God when he was young. The scripture says, "He increased in wisdom and stature." I believe He grew into a faith and confidence in who he was and more importantly what God said that He was. As a result, this affected His relationship with others.

How do you see yourself? The way you see yourself can automatically make people view you the same way. We have already looked at one mirror, via the questions we answered earlier. There is yet another mirror, and that is God's Word.

How do you think God sees you? It is so important to understand how God loves you and desires your fellowship. I'm sure you have heard the words. " A better self-image". That is what you need. The only way to see vourself properly and see is to see in God's Word what he thinks of you. A healthy self-image only comes when you begin to understand how God really sees vou. Knowing this, will give you confidence and then will bring better 'getalongability' with others.


I chose the following scriptures for you to look up. Please take the time to do it. These are some real good ones that show what God thinks of us. This is the best mirror you can look into.

Brother Bedge took me to a Seventh-Day private hospital where they found out that my left lung was rotten and very weak and then I was suffering from birharzia and many other diseases. The doctor, Mr. Mohne, verbally doubted of my life. Brother Bedge took me home. A few days my body was swollen, especially by my legs. Brother Bedge who so courageously took control of my case lost hope also. It appeared my time was now ready to go home. It seemed everybody lost hope.

One day in August, I sat on the verandah while watching the lake. Suddenly I saw Brother Kumuzu Mkandawise coming towards me from Madisi in Sowa district. When I saw him, I leaped to welcome him. When I was standing on the ground I remembered that I was ill. But, when I started to check my body from down my legs, I realized that I was no longer a sick man, but a miraculously healed man, That was my healing hour, and I still praise the Almighty.
